- 1) No new members present
- 2) Minutes from the April meeting read
- 3) Treasurer's Report given by Tina Glow
 - Reimburse Nick and Kay for judges' clinic – OK'd
 - Reimburse Christ for 1 year jetski – OK'd
 - Insurance is \$1119.56 – OK'd to pay
 - Tri tip dinner -- \$103.13 – OK'd
 - To get reimbursed for boat insurance, of \$75 year
 - Must have 3 pledged boat events, w/ current insurance of \$500,000
 - Vote to purchase 2 wakeboard ropes and handles
